



Common Human Resource Information Standards

Member Active Federal Military Service Base Date

Member Active Federal Military Service Base Date is a constructed calendar date identifying when a DoD Military Service member's creditable active military service begins.

Permitted Values

NA

Structural Business Rules

A calendar date must have a day, a month, and a year including century (i.e., YYYYMMDD).

A DoD Military Service member must have only one Member Active Federal Military Service Base Date at a time.

Member Active Federal Military Service Base Date must be reconstructed from Active Duty Begin Date and Active Duty End Date, Full-time National Guard Duty Start Date and Full-time National Guard Duty End Date, and Lost Time Start Date and Lost Time Stop Date when there are breaks in service.
